With the coming of August, families are gearing up for the many activities of school and fall events. After a much needed summer break, I pray that everyone had a chance to rest and enjoy the blessings of summertime! Our parish too is excitedly looking forward to reengaging afresh with ministries, catechesis and apostolic works. First, our preparation course for those interested in becoming Catholic, the **Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults**, RCIA, will begin on September 6th. Please scour the pews and extend the invitation to anyone you think maybe interested in finding out more.

Our **choir programs** offer opportunities to parishioners and professionals, children and adults to lend their musical talents to the worship of God. Please contact Mr. Andrew Mills for more information about how to participate: Amills@arch-no.org.

Catechesis is vital for **sacramental preparation**. Parish young people who desire to receive First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion or the Sacrament of Confirmation this spring will begin their programs in the coming weeks. Other opportunities are slated for the fall and details will be forthcoming. These include a book study for adults and a parish mission preacher in December.

It is also my goal this fall to reengage our **Parish Pastoral Council**. The council had been an important consulting and advisory resource for me when I first arrived three years ago. The events of the pandemic and several parishioners who relocated meant that the council took an unfortunate hiatus. Now is the perfect time to promote participation once again. The Pastoral Council is one of three consultative bodies which serve our parish and assist me in parish leadership. The other two, the Building Committee and Finance Council have been a blessing for me and a source of invaluable wisdom.

The Pastoral Council has the role of assisting the pastor to be aware of and respond to the unique needs of our parishioners. Their advice is essential as decisions are made for future planning and promoting the effective sanctification of our community. The council assists to identify new volunteers and to organize initiatives which can reach out to our neighborhood and our city for the purpose of spreading the Gospel. It is composed of *ex officio* members, such as myself and our parish deacons, as well as appointed and, if possible, elected members. The needs of our parish are indeed unique. We provide for two functioning historic churches and serve parishioners from many different areas in both the English and Latin Mass. I hope that representatives, at least 7 members, from every aspect of our parish life will get involved.

I would like to begin the nomination process by soliciting from each of you a suggestion of who I might appoint to the Pastoral Council. The council will begin by meeting quarterly, the time commitment is minimal, and the only required qualification is a desire to see our parish grow and flourish in Christ's call.
