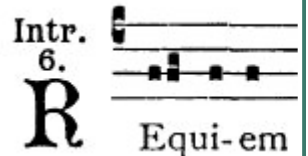

### OUR FATHERS

The following is an excerpt taken from an October 12, 2020 **Crisis Magazine** article by Fr. Peter M. Stravinskias. Fr. Stravinskias is the founder and superior of the Priestly Society of Blessed John Henry Cardinal Newman. He is also president of the Catholic Education Foundation and editor of **The Catholic Response**. The article was entitled **What Can You do To Help Our Priests?**

*Allow me to share with you a personal anecdote that might help illustrate the attitude I'm proposing. Many years ago, eight of my seminary classmates and I went for a Christmastide dinner to Asti's in Manhattan; it was a lovely place, featuring live opera done by the waiters, unfortunately shuttered a long time ago. After a delightful meal and wonderful entertainment by the singing waiters, we asked for our check and were told that it had been "taken care of." When we inquired of the who, the why and the how, we were told the benefactor wished to remain anonymous. Finally, the maitre d' prevailed on our host to allow himself to be identified. Some of us went over to the table to thank him personally. I said, "I hope you know what you got yourself in for, with nine very hungry and thirsty priests tonight!" The man, on holiday with his wife, son and father from the Midwest, smiled and said: "Father, no matter what it costs, we've gotten off cheap tonight. Everything I am, Father, is what the Church has made me—two decades of Catholic education, including a law degree from Notre Dame University, and great priests and nuns. In fact, I just said to my son, 'You see those young priests?'—none of us had any gray hair yet!—"They could have been anything and done anything, but they gave it all up, so that you, your mother, your grandfather and I could have Christ in the sacraments.' Merry Christmas, Fathers."*

## SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Many exciting things are happening at St. Patrick's in the coming weeks. Allow me to expand upon them so you can stay fully informed about the activities of our parish.

First, within the next two weeks **scaffolding will be constructed inside St. Patrick's** for a partial ceiling repair. The several capital projects of previous years (air conditioning, exterior water proofing, roof repairs) have all been carried out with the practical aim of preserving the interior art and architecture of our church building. Now that these are complete, I have invited the company Conrad Schmitt Studio, Inc. to repair a small section of the broken plaster of our ceiling. This small project will only take a few weeks and will give us a sample of what a full-scale repair of the ceiling will look like. Of course, fund raising will need to be done to carry out the full project. I will be explaining more as our yearly Advent Appeal draws closer.

We are joining with other parishes to participate in the **iGiveCatholic fundraising appeal** which starts November 14th. This effort is aimed at a tangible project that will enrich the life of the parish. After consulting our finance councils, I have decided to direct St. Patrick's iGiveCatholic donations toward a new set of vestments. While we are very blessed with a rich selection of vestments already, St. Patrick's will benefit from a solemn vestment set for our Marian celebrations. Our goal for this 12 piece set of Marian white and blue vestments is \$6,000. St. John the Baptist's iGiveCatholic will be directed toward the stained glass window of St. Peter in need of repair. The goal will be \$3,000.

A few months ago, I invited a priest from **Opus Sanctorum Angelorum** to come to St. Patrick's as a **mission preacher**. Fr. William Wagner, OSC, was very gracious to accept the invitation and will offer a Friday evening presentation in the rectory. Saturday morning he will preach the Mass homily at 8am followed by a longer Saturday morning presentation. Fr. Wagner will offer the homilies at the Sunday 9:15am and 11am Masses. Then, please stay after Mass for a final presentation Sunday around noon. Fr. Wagner belongs to a community whose special apostolate is to offer parish missions focused primarily on the Catholic teaching about the angels. His community also fosters devotion to the angels through associations of the lay faithful. His presentations to us will range from the work of the angels in Old and New Testaments to the interaction with angels as witnessed by Christians of various ages as well. He assures me that his presentations will include stories and accounts that will also be engaging for our parish children. Hosting a parish mission is great opportunity to ignite our zeal and also to foster fellowship with one another as a parish family. I sincerely hope you can join in! More details will be forthcoming in the weeks ahead.

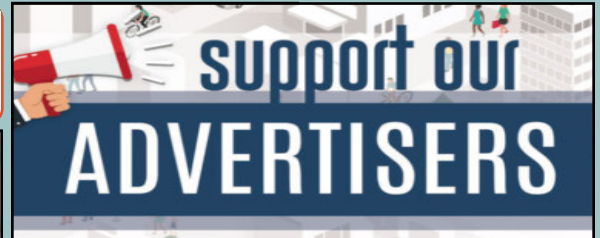
