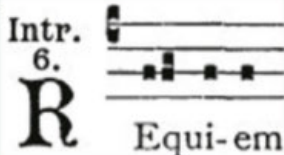
### NOVEMBER PRAYER FOR POOR SOULS

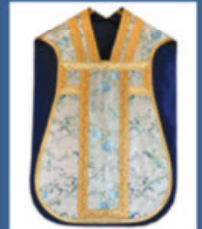

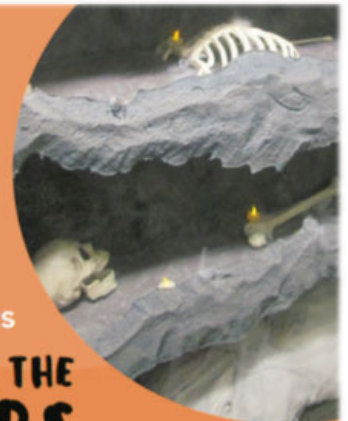

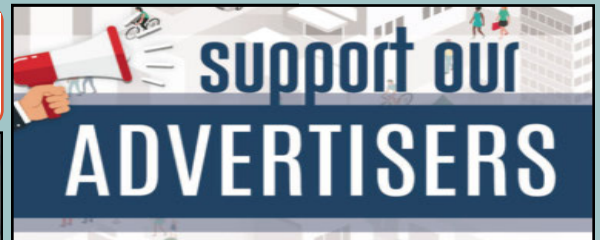
