SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

We focus each year in the month of November upon our duty to pray for the poor souls in Purgatory. On November 1st, the whole Church is assembled to celebrate those innumerable souls who enjoy God's blessings in heaven. Inspired by this hope for eternal glory, we redouble our prayers for those who suffer their necessary purification before receiving their crown. Prayer for the dead is a duty and it evokes sobering themes of death and suffering, but the fruit of this prayer is exceedingly beautiful. With this in mind, we take the opportunity to beautifully engage in this act of worship.

With many thanks to our sponsors, and the hard work of our parish musicians, this year's celebration of **All Souls' Day (November 2nd at 6:30pm)** will be adorned with the music of **Jacobus Clemens non Papa**. Born around 1510, probably in Ypres, Flanders, Clemens started his career of composition in Paris around 1530. He was ordained a priest and composed settings of all 150 psalms. Many of these become popular features of the local culture. He went on to compose 15 settings of the Mass, including the setting for the Requiem Mass that we will hear on November 2nd. He also composed 15 settings of the *Magnificat*. A large number of his other pieces are known to this day for both secular and sacred settings. It is speculated that he obtained the nickname "non-papa" as something of a joke to distinguish him from Pope Clement since their names were so similar. He died at the young age of 45. **Please be sure to join us at All Souls' Day Mass!**

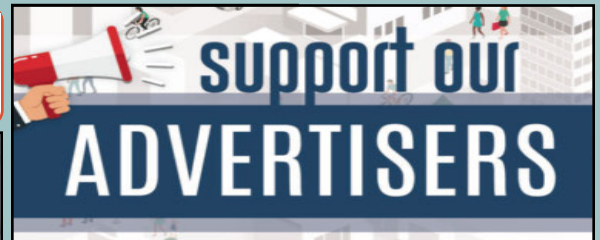
