# SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

The tradition of blessing water and chalk on the feast of the Epiphany are two memorable sacramentals which grace our liturgical observances. The ornate ritual for the Epiphany blessing of water comes to the Latin Church from the Christian East. It begins with the litany of the saints, then three psalms. It proceeds with prayers of exorcism before salt is mixed with the water. The water is then solemnly blessed and the Magnificat and the Te Deum are prayed. The ritual takes place on the eve of the Epiphany and serves as a way to bring a sacramental close to Christmastide. By the devotional use of holy water to bless our homes, and signing ourselves with it we can recall not only our Baptism, but also the graces of the recently-passed Christmas season: Christ's birth has washed us from sin, delivered us from the snares of the enemy, joined us to the family of God and placed rejoicing in our hearts. If you would like me to bless water for you, please deliver a container to the parish office by January 4th. Extra water will be available for a donation while the supply lasts! The blessing will occur in private on January 5th.

The blessing of chalk is rooted in a centuries-old tradition whereby priests would visit and bless the homes of their faithful. When parishioners were too numerous, chalk was blessed so that prayers of blessing could be recited by the family in their own home. The marking of the door with chalk was a public sign of faith and another way to remind ourselves of the blessing of Christ's arrival. The door is marked with the year, four crosses and CMB to invoke the prayers of the three kings who visited Christ: Caspar, Malchoir, Balthazar. The marking occurs in this way: 20+C+M+B+23 Blessed chalk and instructions will be available after Mass next weekend. May the Lord bless your families this Christmastide and grant you a grace-filled New Year! ~Fr. O'Brien
