

LENTEN FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

In addition, **Fridays during Lent** are <u>obligatory days of abstinence</u>. This penance includes forgoing meat from warm blooded animals and animal products the contain or confer the flavor of meat.

The norms concerning **abstinence** from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church <u>from age 14 onwards</u>.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on **fasting** are obligatory <u>from age 18 until age 59</u>. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. If possible, the fast **on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil** (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection
