## SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Now that we've reached the mid-point of Lent, I would encourage you to take advantage of the many opportunities that the coming days offer. To begin, today, we celebrate sung **vespers according to the Breviarium Romanum at 4 p.m.** with Benediction. We make the special effort to celebrate vespers in observance of Laetare Sunday to further sanctify Sunday as a day for rest and worship, and particularly on this Sunday to foster joy through sacred music and divine worship. The **Feast of St. Joseph** is transferred to tomorrow. Saturday, March 25th is the **Feast of the Annunciation**, a solemn Mass will be offered at 9:15 a.m.

After the joyful celebrations of St. Patrick, St. Joseph, Laetare and the Annunciation, the mood of our Lenten observance takes on a much more somber tone. This allows us to focus on the Lord's love as He suffers for us. Passiontide begins with the 5th Sunday of Lent. The veils over our sacred images represent a fast for the eyes and a reminder to intensify our prayer. The second Sunday of Passiontide is **Palm Sunday**. Please note the special Mass times for Sunday morning: 7:30 a.m., 9:00 a.m., and 11:15 a.m. Palm Sunday inaugurates Holy Week, the most sacred time of our liturgical year. The goal of our Lenten penances aims toward a fruitful participation in the very mysteries unfolding during Holy Week. If you take Lent seriously (as we all should), we must take Holy Week seriously!

Attending the liturgies of the Sacred Triduum allows us to experience with the whole Church, the events of our salvation. **Holy Thursday** is celebrated at 6:30 p.m. with the Mass of the Lord's Supper, commemorating the institution of the priesthood, and our Lord's arrest with a Eucharistic procession to the altar of repose. On **Good Friday** (3 p.m.) the Church's prayer is substantially different, the sacrifice of the Mass is not offered, but rather, the Passion is chanted and the Church offers her solemn intercessions. Holy Saturday bring us to silent contemplation of the dead Christ, then climaxes with the **Easter Vigil** at 8 p.m. There, we recount salvation history, baptize our catechumen, and begin the rejoicing of the Easter Season. **Easter Sunday** is our feast of feasts, the font of our hope! Please notice the special Mass schedule. To foster our joy and aid our worship, we will hear the *Missa Santi Gabrielis* by J.M. Haydn at the 9 a.m., and 11 a.m. Masses. ~Fr. O'Brien
