
VESPERS ON SUNDAY MARCH 9

SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Effective on Ash Wednesday, priests of the English speaking world have now begun to use the new translation of the prayer of absolution in the Sacrament of Confession. It is being phased in between now and Holy Week. Recall that since 2011, the Church has been reissuing liturgical translations to bring them more into greater conformity with the original Latin. The Sacrament of Confession is the most recent to benefit from the effort. While the changes are very slight, the new text reminds us that fidelity in small matters will be blessed by God! Having translations that better represent the Latin is a tangible reminder of the universality that binds Catholics around the world and across time.

Here is the text of absolution in Latin:

Deus, Pater misericordiárum, qui per mortem et resurrectiónem Filii sui mundum sibi reconciliávit et Spiritum Sanctum effúdit in remissiónem peccatórum, per ministérium Ecclésiæ indulgéntiam tibi tribuat et pacem. Et ego te absólvo a peccátis tuis in nómine Patris, et Filii, + et Spíritus Sancti.


Here is the old translation in English with the amended text underlined:

God, the Father of mercies, through the death and resurrection of His Son has reconciled the world to Himself and <u>sent the Holy Spirit</u> <u>among us</u> for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God <u>give</u> you pardon and peace, and **I** absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, + and of the Holy Spirit.

Finally, here is the new translation of the text with the changes underlined:

God, the Father of mercies, through the death and resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and <u>poured out the Holy</u> <u>Spirit for</u> the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God <u>grant</u> you pardon and peace, and **I absolve you from your** sins in the name of the Father, + and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

This new translation is an opportunity to reflect on these words and meditate on the mystery they communicate. May our appreciation of this Sacrament ever deepen for, truly, God's mercy has been won for us by the Precious Blood of our Savior! ~Fr. O'Brien
