## Collect

Fiat, Domine, quaesumus, per gratiam tuam fructuosus nostræ devotionis affectus: quia tunc nobis proderunt suscepta jejunia, si tuæ sint placita pietati. Per Dominum.

*Make fruitful by Thy grace, we beseech Thee, O Lord, the zeal of our fervent devotion; for only if it please Thee shall the fasting we have undertaken be of benefit to us. Through our Lord.*

## Secret

Oblationibus nostris, quaesumus, Domine, placare susceptis: et ad te nostras etiam rebelles compelle propitiis voluntates. Per Dominum.

*Graciously accept our offerings, O Lord, we beseech Thee, and mercifully direct our still rebellious wills to Thee. Through our Lord.*

## Postcommunion

Tua nos, quaesumus, Domine, sancta purifcent: et operatione sua tibi placitos esse perficiant. Per Dominum.

*May Thy holy Sacrament cleanse us, we beseech Thee, O Lord, and may its power make us pleasing unto Thee. Through our Lord.*
