SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

With great joy, I would like to welcome all guests and parishioners to our celebration of the Lord's glorious Resurrection! The disciplines of Lent have built up within us new virtues, and we are jubilant to share in our Lord's victory. In Him alone are we conquerors of death!

This very joy has reverberated throughout the ages and has been expressed in every tongue! To greet this, our day of rejoicing, Christians have sung a hymn, "Hail thee, festival day!" for many centuries. Recently, a parishioner shared with me the original Latin poem from which this hymn takes its inspiration, written by Venantius Fortunatus (†609). Please enjoy the small excerpt below.

Salve, festa dies, toto venerabilis aevo,
 qua Deus infernum vicit et astra tenet.
 Nobilitas anni, mensum decus, arma dierum,
 horarum splendor, scripula, puncta fovens,
 Hinc tibi silva comis plaudit, hinc campus aristis,
 hinc grates tacito palmitis vitis agit.
 Si tibi nunc avium resonant virgulta susurro,
 has inter minimus passer amore cano.
 Christe, salus rerum, bone conditor atque redemptor,
 unica progenies ex deitate patris,
 Irrecitabiliter manans de core parentis,
 verbum subsistens et penetrare potens,
 aequalis, concors, socius, cum patre coaevus,
 quo sumpsit mundus principe principium,
 aethera suspendis, sola congeris, aequora fundis,
 quaeque locis habitant quo moderante vigent,
 qui genus humanum cernens mersisse profundo,
 ut hominem eriperes es quoque factus homo;
 nec voluisti etiam tantum te corpore nasci,
 sed caro quae nasci pertulit atque mori.
 Funeris exequias pateris vitae auctor et orbis;
 intra mortis iter dando salutis opem.
 Tristia cesserunt infernae vincula legis
 expavitque chaos luminis ore premi.
 Depereunt Tenebrae Christi fulgore fugatae
 et tetrae noctis pallia crassa cadunt.

Translated (Michael Roberts, tr.):

"Greetings, holy day, revered for the whole of time, when God conquered hell and took possession of the stars. Ennobler of the year, glory of the months, and bulwark of the days, illuminator of hours, nourisher of minutes and seconds, here the forest acclaims you with its leaves, here the field with its crops, and here the vine gives thanks to you with its silent shoots. If thickets now ring with the gentle whispering of birds, I, the humblest sparrow, among them singing from love.

"Christ, salvation of the world, its gracious creator and redeemer, sole offspring of the divinity of the Father, ineffably originating from the heart of your parent, existing as word with all-penetrating power, his equal and companion, harmonious and coeternal with the Father, wonder whose reign the world had its beginning, you hold up the sky, you amass the earth, make flow the sea, and by your governance make their inhabitants flourish, who seeing that the human race was submerged in the depths, were made man yourself to rescue man from that fate. Not only were you willing to be born in bodily form, but the flesh which suffered birth also suffered death. Creator of life and the world, you endure the rituals of burial, and entered upon the path of death bringing the blessing of salvation. The cruel bonds of the infernal law give way, and chaos feared extinction when confronted by light. Darkness perishes, put to flight by Christ's brilliance, and the thick cloak of loathsome night falls to the ground."

May the glory of the Lord dispel every darkness, and fill you and your loved ones with new hope!
