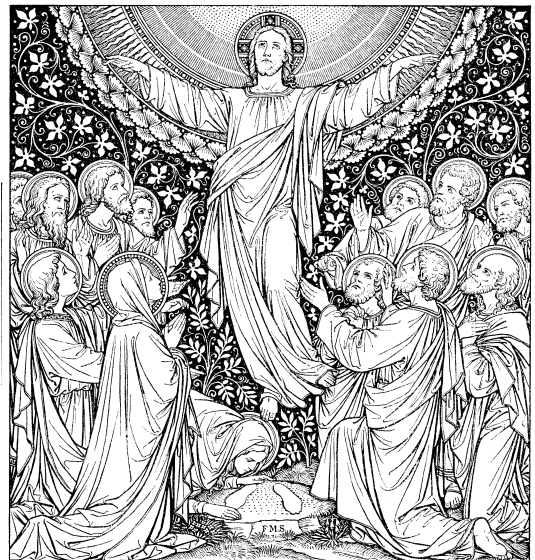

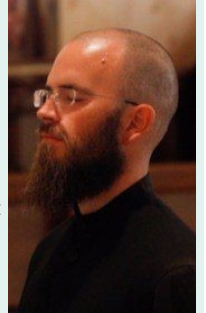
BENEDICTINE MONK OF NORCIA TO VISIT ST. PATRICK'S

Father Martin Bernhard, OSB, a monk of the Monastery of Norcia in Italy will join us for the 9:15 a.m. Mass on Sunday, May 14.

Norcia is the birthplace of St. Benedict where a Benedictine community was reestablished in 1998.

The community follows the ancient monastic rule of St. Benedict and celebrates their liturgies in the older use of the Latin rite. The community is also well-known for Bierra Nursia, their own brewing operation that provides vital financial support to sustain and expand their monastic efforts, especially after a 2016 earthquake that severely damaged the monastery.

Father Bernhard will be available to connect with supporters and spread awareness of their community at a reception in the courtyard immediately following the 9:15 a.m. Mass. Please join us!

SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Before continuing my series on the virtues, let me bring to your attention some important parish news. First, please join me in congratulating our St. Louis Medallion recipients for this year. For St. Patrick's Church, **Mr. Monty Fernandez** was recognized for his generous volunteer work in our parish office and sacristy. For St. John the Baptist **Mr. and Mrs. Ed Moll** were recognized for their "sweat equity" contributing to the beauty and upkeep of the beautiful church with the golden steeple! Loving volunteers contribute to our community in so many ways; to them all we owe a debt of gratitude!

Please plan to come to parish **Confirmation Mass**, it will be held Saturday May 20th at 10am. Canon Matthew Talarico will be celebrating and administering the sacrament at the delegation of Archbishop Aymond.

Of course, **I wish to all of our mothers a joyful and grace filled Mother's Day.** May the Blessed Mother, whom we honor today with flowers, help you to experience anew the love and gratitude of all you serve!

Continuing to reflect on how the resurrection should change our lives, I would like to consider today the virtue of fortitude. Fortitude is the first of the cardinal virtues. In this case, 'cardinal' comes from the Latin *cardo* meaning hinge. All other salutary qualities 'hinge' on the four principle human virtues: fortitude, justice, temperance, prudence. These four were discussed by the ancient Greeks and are well rooted in scripture; they expounded upon by Augustine, Aquinas and countless others.

Fortitude is "firmness in difficulty and constancy in pursuit of the good." (CCC 1837). Fortitude as a virtue (that is, a habit or disposition) excels brute courage that stems from mere passion, and goes beyond the ability to engage the arduous (for example, a single heroic act done once or only a few times). The virtue is best shown by the habit of doing what is difficult. In a natural sense, this virtue urges us on toward greatness in our temporal affairs, but the supernatural virtue of fortitude drives us to engage in what is spiritually excellent. The highest example of this is shown in the martyrs who received the grace to endure every difficulty with firmness for God's glory.

Cultivating fortitude allows us to tame our irascible appetites, meaning our impulses of passions like anger will be redirected toward obtaining and delighting in a good rather than the mere outburst of the emotion itself. As we gain freedom to direct our passions toward an arduous good, we see subvirtues flower as well: we seek daily excellence (a virtue known as magnificence); we strive to excel in the spiritual life (magnanimity); our ability to accept unavoidable evil and suffer it with stability of soul grows (patience). Perseverance flows from fortitude because by it we persist in our pursuit of the good. Longanimity is the skill of waiting for an arduous good, a strength that will serve us well in Purgatory. Mortification deadens our fear of suffering as it sharpens our ability to see the good despite discomfort.

If we suffer from the vices of fear (cowardice, inane glory, effeminacy, stinginess), then fortitude should be our focus. Fortitude moderates fear and increases our freedom due to a confidence that the pursuit of the good will be fulfilled in attaining God's blessings and perfect love! ~Fr. O'Brien
