



# SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

<u>Images of Hope: Meditations on Major Feasts</u> is a beautiful little book by then Cardinal Ratzinger, who later became Pope Benedict XVI. The Cardinal combines Scripture, history, literature, and theology in unique reflections on the Church's major feasts. Here is an excerpt from the book on the Feast of Corpus Christi using the image of a crucified Christ from the great apse mosaic of the church of San Clemente in Rome, shown below.

"If we enter the historically rich church of San Clemente in Rome...our eye remains fixed on the picture of Christ in the middle. Christ has inclined his head and given his spirit into the hands of his Father. A great peace emanates from His face, from his entire figure. Earthly life is extinguished, but love remains. The Resurrection thus shines already through the scene of crucifixion.

"If we linger before the mosaic, we notice that this Cross is in realty a tree, from which four sources of water originate. At which deer slake their thirst. The tree that comes from living waters is fertile. We now notice that the rich network of branches that fills the entire breadth of the picture is not simply an ornament. It is a great vine whose branches grow forth from the roots and limbs of the tree of the Cross. They extend over the whole world...and the world itself becomes a single large vineyard.

"When the apse of San Clemente was created, there was no feast of Corpus Christi. The sense of that day is, however, wonderfully represented here. For it shows, indeed, how the Eucharist spans the world and transforms it. The Eucharist belongs not only in the Church and to a closed community. The world should become eucharistic, should live in the vine of God. But that is Corpus Christi: to celebrate the Eucharist cosmically; to carry it even to our streets and squares so that the world, from the fruit of the new vine, may receive healing and reconciliation through the tree of life of the Cross of Jesus Christ."
