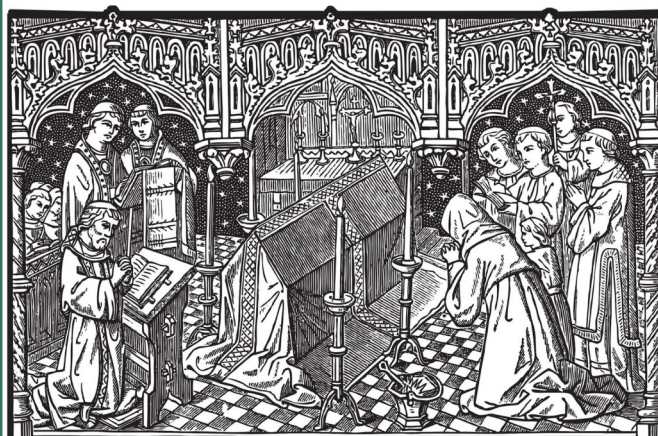

SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Earlier in September, Archbishop Aymond called together the priests of our archdiocese in our annual convocation. The time together was a blessed opportunity to renew our fraternity as priests serving Christ's faithful of our area. We also had several presentations focused on fostering discipleship among the churched and the un-churched. The talks were an important reminder that Evangelization is always a top priority for priests and laity alike!

As you may have heard, during the convocation some important news was shared about some financial challenges that the archdiocese is facing. The first of these is increasing insurance costs. Our two churches continue to see rising costs. I will be in discussions with our two finance councils about how to best address this challenge. More information will be published to the parishioners when I complete the report for last fiscal year. As always, feel free to contact me directly if you would like more information. The second financial challenge pertains to the archdiocesan bankruptcy. Not many details are known at this point, but it does seem highly likely that parishes will be made to contribute toward the final settlement amount of the archdiocesan bankruptcy proceeding. While I may not have much ability to influence the decisions that are made, I promise to be transparent as details are shared with me. I consider my duty to be a trustworthy steward of your financial donations as a serious responsibility- one that is essential to my paternal care of this family of faith. Let us pray that God's holy will would be done in the challenges that we face; let us also put our heads together to ensure the continued flourishing of our communities!

In the midst of these challenges, God continues to summon young and old to seek and do His will! Our parish has several young parishioners who are intently considering priesthood and religious life. For them, I sincerely ask your prayers! Along those lines, and with Archbishop Aymond's blessing, I have been able to welcome Simon Atkinson to reside at St. Patrick's while he applies to seminary. Simon will be helping us with maintenance duties and liturgical tasks around the parish. Please take the opportunity to introduce yourself! Below, Simon shares about his background.
