SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Each November, the iGiveCatholic campaign is an opportunity for our parishioners and friends to financially help our two churches with a specific project. This year, both St. Patrick's and St. John the Baptist have plans that would serve as visible improvements to our campuses. May I encourage you to participate so that we can accomplish these goals and keep our churches looking their best for God's glory?

At St. Patrick's, we experienced the loss of one of our exterior shrines due to vandalism several months ago. Since then, our memorial to the victims of abortion has been lacking a statue. The previous statue was a small resin angel which had little material value. Thus, there was no insurance reimbursement for the loss. However, we are taking this as an opportunity to improve the shrine with a new cast bronze statue. After requesting suggestions from the parishioners, the best way forward is the statue pictured below.

The image is a replica of an image found at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse, Wisconsin founded by His Eminence, Raymond Cardinal Burke. The statue depicts Our Lady of Guadalupe seated, and in her arms are the children entrusted to her special care as the patroness of the unborn and those threatened by abortion. Our statue will be small in scale, but still a beautiful reminder of the graces obtained by Our Lady of Guadalupe, namely the conversion of millions of native people and the end of violent pagan sacrifices. The funds will also provide for other courtyard improvements. Our goal is \$6,000.



St. John the Baptist Church has endured many years with rot affecting one of the bell tower's wooden louvers. This has caused the louvers to shift or fall out all together! The area where this occurred is very visible to the passers-by on the elevated Pontchartrain Expressway. Upon closer inspection, it appears that the damaged pieces can be replaced rather economically. Therefore, with financial help from our

faithful, we can provide for a (hopefully) speedy facelift for the 150 year old church. Our goal is \$3,000.
