**NOVEMBER PRAYER FOR POOR SOULS**

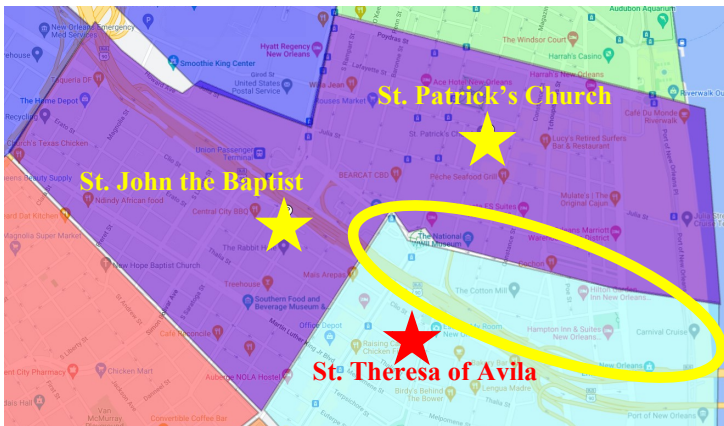

# **SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE**

Two weeks ago, Archbishop Aymond had some very difficult news to announce regarding a number of our struggling archdiocesan churches. After many months of analysis and consultation, several churches will need to be shuttered due to dwindling attendance and financial shortfalls. In our area, St. Theresa of Avila will be closed and the territory merged into the neighboring parishes. This is quite a sad loss for our neighborhood. Not only is St. Theresa of Avila 175 years old, but it is also a church very dear to our saintly Margaret Haughery, the 19th century “Mother of the Orphans.”

St. Patrick’s has been designated to receive a portion of the territory currently being served by St. Theresa. The diagram below denotes the combined territory of St. Patrick’s and St. John the Baptist in purple. The yellow oval below shows the territory we will assume. The vast majority of our faithful live outside of our canonical territory, but canon law still provides for the care of the faithful based on territorial boundaries. Thus, St. Patrick’s will assume a partial role in the care of souls, as well as the disposition of assets and liabilities pertaining to St. Theresa properties and territory.

Many details of this transition have yet to be spelled out. In the meantime, please pray for those who will soon lose their spiritual home. By God’s grace, may our parish community welcome those individuals affected, and continue to shine the light of the Gospel in downtown New Orleans. ~Fr. O’Brien
