SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

With only a week and a half to go before the start of Lent, may I invite you to bring before the Lord our annual duty of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The whole city is abuzz with Carnival celebrations, but as we pray the Holy Mass together today, please take a moment to look forward to the top of the mountain: the peak toward which Carnival and Lent lead, the Sacred Paschal Triduum, celebrating our Lord's resurrection.

Prayer, fasting and almsgiving need to be part of our year-round routine of spiritual practices, of course. However, when all Catholics intensify these practices during Lent, we can each feel the encouragement that comes along with a shared effort toward a common goal. Much like the various members of a sports team who meet to practice and exercise together for additional encouragement and motivation, so too does Lent bolster our efforts toward excellence and holiness.

Today, please find below the Church's regulation regarding Lenten fasting. Keep in mind that these laws bind us in conscience. But rather than a burden, they serve to build an esprit de corps among the family of God as we prepare for all the blessings that come with the Feast of Feasts!

Canon Law (cann. 1249– 1253) clarifies our obligation toward fast and abstinence during Lent. First, there are two **days of obligatory fast: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.** On these days, Catholics between 18 and 59 inclusive are obliged to fast and abstain from meat. To fast from food on these days means, at a minimum, to take only one meal (meatless), and, if necessary, to take one or two smaller meals which together do not equal more than a full meal. If anything needs to be taken between meals, it must be liquid only. Recommended by the US bishops is the Paschal Fast: observing a fast from the liturgy of Holy Thursday until the conclusion of the Easter Vigil.

Abstinence from meat is required of all Catholic 14 years of age and older on the Fridays of Lent, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means that we will not eat warm-blooded animal flesh on these days, nor the by-products of meat which contain meat flavor, such as chicken stock, etc. Dairy products, eggs, shortening of animal fat, and cold-blooded animals are permitted on days of abstinence. ~Fr.
