SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

I have the pleasure today, to offer our parish an important update regarding a long-term goal of our building maintenance. We have now completed the process of consultations and permissions, and will proceed this summer with our church ceiling restoration work! As you recall, after several different building maintenance projects to protect our interior plaster, we consulted with Conrad Schmidt Studio for their proposal for our ceiling restoration. Conrad Schmidt was the last contractor to renovate our ceiling about 35 years ago. However, the scale of the repair is less extensive this time; in addition the work does not require the level of expertise that their studio offers. As a result, we found their proposal to be too costly.

After that, we consulted with a highly-regarded local expert, Keith Guy, Inc. His proposal amounted to half of the cost of the other. Moreover, Keith Guy, Inc, has had a long-time connection with restoring New Orleans churches, including significant work at St. Patrick's as well. With all this in mind, I consulted with our parish Finance Council, Pastoral Council, and Building Committee. Then, reviewing the proposals with archdiocesan officials, we received permission to proceed with the project.

The project is a major undertaking! We project that the scaffolding will be present in the church for 90 days. Our scaffolding contractor has designed the system to minimize obstructions to visibility. But, of course, these are unavoidable to some extent. Keith Guy, Inc. knows the importance of facilitating the use of the church while the project is underway. As such, we do plan to have our normal Mass schedule for the duration of the project. In anticipation of this project, we have prevented weddings from being scheduled in the church between May 18th and October 2nd. As such, the scaffolding could begin assembly the week of May 20th.

The total cost of the project comes to just over \$660,000. This includes materials and labor for both the scaffolding and work required on the ceiling. The scope of the project will refurbish all painted areas of the church interior except those artistically painted such as the three frescos, and areas of faux marble/faux wood. The project aims to restore the church interior exactly as it was in the last renovation, namely, that of Monsignor Reynolds, which concluded in 1990.

Because of the generosity of our parishioners and the providence of God, we currently have the funds in our restoration savings to complete this project. However, other capital projects are looming as well. Despite our roof repair a few years ago, a new leak has developed indicating that more work will need to be done before the ceiling project begins. In addition, the electronics of our interior lighting system has been slowly failing over past several years. Replacement parts for it are no longer produced and a new system is quite costly. In addition, prudence dictates that we keep savings for an emergency, particularly on the threshold of hurricane season! As such, I do anticipate a special fund-raising campaign in the near future. Details will be forthcoming.

So many parishioners have stepped up to assist in the various building needs of our beloved spiritual home. I am deeply grateful for all those who have lent their expertise and their financial support for these undertakings. I look forward to providing updates as progress is made! ~ Fr. O'Brien
