SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Sincere congratulations to Miss Vivian Cerruti, a St. Patrick's parishioner who won the Archdiocesan Youth Leadership Award! Vivian has demonstrated her faith though many acts of service and faithful leadership among her peers at her Catholic high school. Let us praise God for her many gifts and pray for her future as she heads to college.

It is also a joy to offer some news from the priestly vocations front. The Holy Spirit has used St. Patrick's in many ways to foster vocations to the priesthood among our own parishioners. And for those who are in formation from other parishes, our church has been a font of refreshment and beauty. Please pray for the following men who have claimed St. Patrick's as a spiritual home and now offer themselves in priestly formation. Mr. Joe Martello was raised at St. Patrick's and is in his fifth year at Notre Dame Seminary. He studies for the Archdiocese of New Orleans and is on track for ordination as a transitional deacon in about a year. Mr. Curtis Zuckermann started coming to St. Patrick's during high school and has been studying for the Fraternity of St. Peter in Nebraska for about five years. He too is about one year away from receiving the major orders of subdeacon and deacon. Mr. Andrew Fourcade has been singing with our choir, and now has been accepted into the monastery at St. Joseph's Abbey. Mr. Stephen Ecuyer has been a regular at daily Mass and discerned a call to a life of prayer with the Carmelite hermits in Pennsylvania. He entered the community only a few weeks ago. Other seminarians from Notre Dame have joined us regularly for sacred worship and I commend them to your prayers as well. In addition, there are several others who are actively attuned to God's call toward the priesthood and religious life. May the Lord continue to stir His love in their souls!

Lastly, I offer an update regarding the renovation projects at St. Patrick's. On April 14th, I detailed the scaffolding and ceiling work to be done this summer. Scaffolding will be constructed the last week of May and will remain for at least 90 days. In the process of attending to our latest roof leak, a roofer offered us a very attractive proposal for an entirely new roof. After consulting with members of our parish committees and the archdiocese, I accepted the proposal for a new roof at the cost of \$245,000. The work is set to begin on April 29th. This means that our savings reserves will soon be very low. So, in short order we hope to inaugurate a campaign to replenish our reserves and set a good foundation for the other projects that are needed in the near future. I continue to praise God for the generosity of so many people who care for our beloved St. Patrick's!
