NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL 2024

The Bishops of the United States have called for a National Eucharistic Revival which will culminate in two major national events:

Four cross-country Eucharistic Pilgrimages from the North, South, East and West will converge at the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis in July.

The Archdiocese of New Orleans is on the Southern "Juan Diego" pilgrimage route and we will welcome pilgrims from June 7-9.

There will be three public events in the Archdiocese.
