## NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL 2024

The Bishops of the United States have called for a National Eucharistic Revival which will culminate in two major national events: Four cross-country Eucharistic Pilgrimages from the North, South, East and West will converge at the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis in July.
