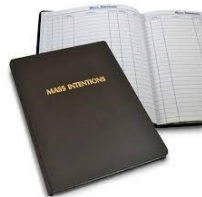

RESTORATION UPDATE

This past week in our renovation efforts:

- A brief update about the lighting strike. The total cost of repairs is approaching \$30,000 for the various systems affected. We have begun the insurance claim process and do anticipate coverage after we pay our \$1,000 deductible.
- The repaired electronics for the organ have arrived to our repair technician, we hope to have it installed by the end of June.
- Scaffolding assembly projected date of completion: June 26th.
- Negotiations with our roofing contractor have determined that a delay in the roofing project would most prudent. A start-date of September 1st would allow for additional planning as well as better weather during the construction phase. He plans on 10 working days to complete our project.
- Overall completion date is September 30th.
