## RESTORATION UPDATE

This past week in our renovation efforts:

- The painters have continued debris removal of failed plaster. They also began cleaning the candle soot from the gallery ceiling resulting in a noticeable, immediate improvement!
- Scaffolding assembly may require a few more days. Projected date of scaffolding completion: June 12th.
- Projected start date for the new roof: June 17th.
- I miscalculated my “optimistic” overall completion date since I forgot to factor in scaffold construction and removal. A more realistic overall completion date is September 20th.
