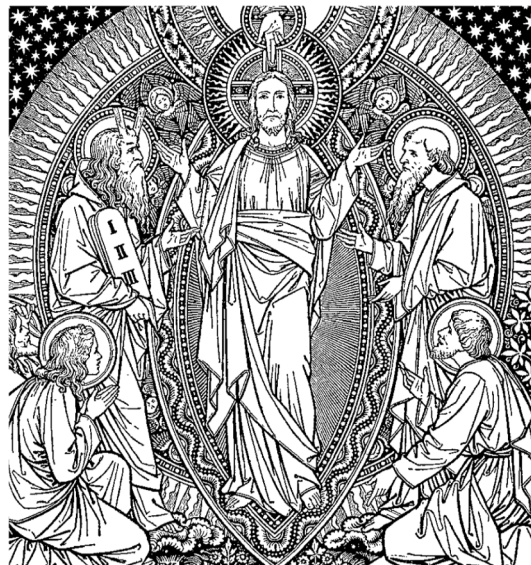

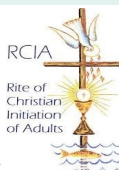

RESTORATION UPDATE

This past week in our renovation efforts:

- The painters continue to focus their efforts on the nave ceiling.
- Scaffolding has been removed from the narthex. See below for a detail of an often-missed feature of our narthex ceiling.
- Regarding our roofing project, the daily afternoon rains have proven the effectiveness of our latest roof repair/replacement strategy. Roof replacement is still set to being in early September.
- Entergy has begun to work on our parish property. While this might partially obstruct walkways on our campus, we are in discussions with them to make the work as little obtrusive as possible. At the completion of the project, all walkways affected will be concreted at no cost to the parish.
- Overall completion date is September 30th.
