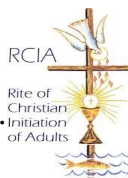

RESTORATION UPDATE

This past week in our renovation efforts:

- Concrete repair and gas line connection has been completed. In addition, the city of New Orleans sent a contractor to repair the street lights that had been damaged since hurricane Ida. Now the lights which illuminate our bell tower are functioning again.
- The size of the crew working on our ceiling project has increased and the pace of progress is encouraging.
- I met with the painting contractor and the scaffolding contractor to talk about the steps and timeline to complete the project. They reported that their work is on time. While there will be some final painting work to complete after the scaffolding is removed, we are planning for the scaffolding removal by October 7th. This is just in time for our next scheduled wedding on October 12th.



NEW STATUE BLESSING

On the feast of the Assumption, we had the privilege to bless a new bronze statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe. It was the fruit of last's years iGive Catholic campaign.



Thanks to all those who contributed to the effort! Because of this fundraising, we acquired the statue, a new concrete plinth; plus, new brass hand-rails are on the way for the handicap ramp.
