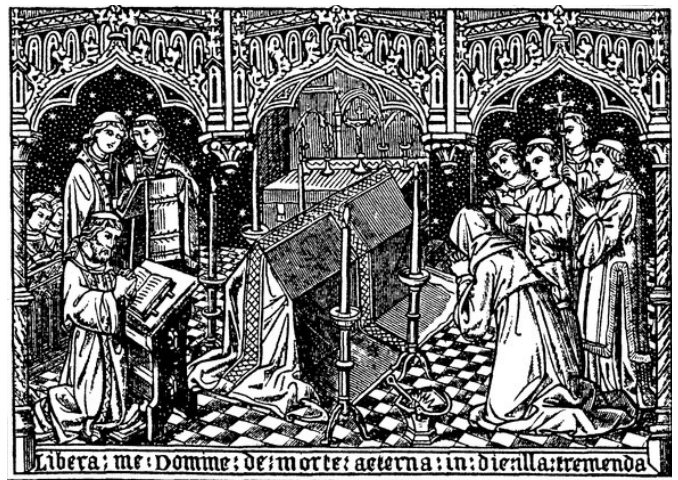

RESTORATION UPDATE

This past week in our renovation efforts:

- As expected, Hurricane Francine came through with wind and rains. We were prepared, however, and despite the foibles of our old roof, we were able to protect the renovation work on our ceiling from the predictable water intrusion. As soon as the scaffolding workers vacate our property with the last of their equipment (October 8th), our roofer will begin the roof replacement. Even though Francine cost our painters one day of work, the crew was able to adjust for the delay.
- As I write, the scaffolders are beginning the removal of the scaffold. The painters are nearly finished, they continue to address the fine details to complete our project on time. Thanks be to God!



REQUIEM ENROLLMENT

2024—2025 Requiem Mass Enrollment

What is a Mass Enrollment? A Mass enrollment is the perfect way for you to have a series of Masses offered for your loved ones. Offering the Mass for a particular intention, such as the souls of those we love, is one way we can be certain that the graces of the Mass are being applied toward our intention.

What is a Requiem Mass? The Requiem Mass is the Church's official prayer for the faithful departed. The ceremonies of the 1962 Missal Requiem Mass require special ceremonies and prayers of the priest, most famously, the praying of the *Dies irae*, and on solemn occasions, the absolution of the catafalque.

How long does the enrollment last? Those who are enrolled will be included in the Mass intention at all the Requiem Masses at St. Patrick's from November 2nd, 2024 through October of 2025. In the year ahead, we have 14 Requiem Masses scheduled.

How do I sign up my departed loved ones? You can find the enrollment form in the Narthex, or call the parish office. The suggested donation is \$150.

How do I notify my family or friends that I have enrolled a loved one? St. Patrick's has designed a beautiful commemorative card that we will send to the address of your choice. A snapshot of this card is seen below, and a sample is found in the narthex.
