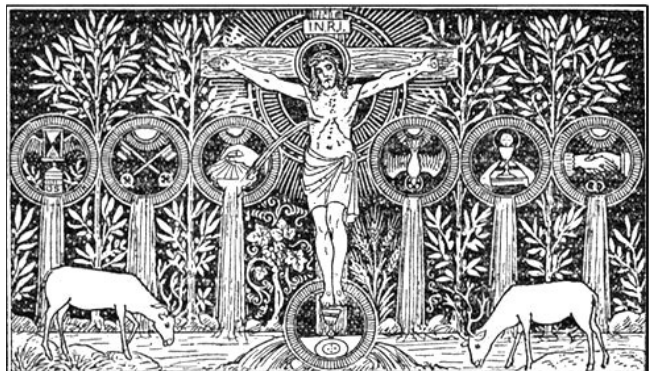

## RESTORATION UPDATE

This past week in our renovation efforts:

- Our painters are resolute to complete the ceiling renovation on time. After our inspection and approval, we plan to begin the scaffolding disassembly on September 16th. The scaffolders will begin by removing the upper platforms. Then the disassembly will continue until the week of October 7th.
- Since the scaffolders need space in our parking lot, in addition to the unfavorable weather forecast for early September, we have decided to again delay our roof replacement project. As a result, the roof replacement will be carried out once the scaffolders vacate the parking lot in mid-October.



## SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

When I arrived at St. Patrick's, I noticed how beautifully Fr. Klores had fostered the devotion of praying for the Holy Souls in Purgatory. We have kept the custom of offering the traditional Latin Requiem Mass regularly to continue this pious practice. Currently, our parish's liturgical calendar includes 4 sung Requiem Masses and 10 low Masses specifically aimed at obtaining succor for those being purified by the flames of Purgatory.

In order that more of the faithful may join their beloved dead to these Requiem Masses, **I am very happy to announce the inauguration of St. Patrick's very own Enrollment for Requiem Masses.** This means that the Mass intention for these 14 Requiem Masses will be dedicated for all the departed who are enrolled. **The enrollment includes a beautiful card that can be sent to family or friends of the one you enroll.** A snapshot of the card is shown below. Enrolling a departed loved one includes them in St. Patrick's Requiem Masses from November 2nd, 2024 and lasts one year.

**We ask a donation of \$150 per intention, and the enrollment can be arranged by contacting our parish office. You can also find envelopes in the narthex to submit your intentions as well.** Praying for the dead is a spiritual work of mercy, and a vital way of expressing our continued love for those who have gone before us!
