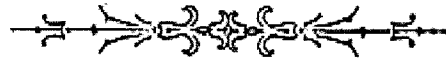

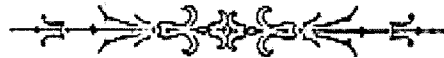
HYMN: *Virgin-born, we bow before Thee* (MON DIEU, PRÊTE-MOI L'OREILLE)

That watched Thy slumbering infancy.

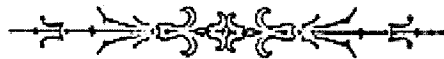
2 Blessèd she by all creation,
