Restoration Update

This past week in our renovation efforts:

- The painters have only some small areas to complete on the great arch over the sanctuary and the choir loft stairwells. Their work won't interfere at all with weekend Masses and should be completed in two weeks.
- Our statue cleaning has begun. It is our goal to have the statues cleaned by mid-November. Other artistic repair work will continue.
- The scaffolders were true to their word and removed all the bars and platforms.
- Before the start of our roof work, a water proofer has addressed an area of concern on the exterior of the northwest corner of the church.
- Our roofer is finalizing plans and gathering materials. He plans to be on site and removing our roof by October 22nd.
- While the interior work is wrapping up, we still have a lot of projects underway. Please continue to pray for God's blessings on our efforts!
