RESTORATION UPDATE

This past week in our renovation efforts:

- The painters have continued to address cleaning tasks and fine detail work to complete our project. There will be some painting to complete once the scaffold has been removed, but the project is nearing its end!
- The scaffolders are making quick progress with the scaffolding removal. At this point it appears that our completion date of Octo-



ber 8th is still within reach. Thanks be to God!

Ever since the renovation project began, I have been sincerely touched by the supportive and encouraging words from our parishioners and visitors. Moreover, the response to our capital campaign has been amazing! At this point, we've raised over \$200,000 toward our goal of \$300,000. The campaign will continue through December.

In an unexpected display of Divine Providence, St. Patrick's was recently the beneficiary of a bequest. The financial gift was made in memory of Mr. Michael L. Thiele, II. He was an architect who made his career in New Orleans and had a great affinity for the historic structures our city, particularly St. Patrick's. The gift will be instrumental in the next phase of our renovations, including the roof for our rectory, and the church lighting system. In your kindness, please pray for the repose of Mr. Thiele's soul, and for all our benefactors!

It is my prayer that the current renovation represents not just a face lift for our building, but an act of loving devotion for God. We are renovating our church because of the renovation of soul that we have each undeservedly received from God! And so, as the scaffolding comes down, I am inviting all of our parishioners to express their gratitude to God in a special way. Because we have focused so much attention within the walls of the church building, I hope that this act of gratitude can be aimed outward. Therefore, on October 12th and 13th, St. Patrick's will observe a "Day of Thanks & Giving."
