ADULT CONFIRMATION COURSE

Class is **Sunday, November 17, 2024** from 12:15-1:30 p.m.

This past week in our renovation efforts:

- Finally our organ has been uncovered and the choir loft thoroughly cleaned.
- Our parish maintenance staff and volunteers are nearly finished painting projects in the choir loft.
- Restoration work on several statues and statue bases will continue in the weeks ahead.
- Our roofing project has encountered a set back. After installing new ply wood and weatherproofing, leaks were discovered the night of October 31st. While the leaks were prevented from affecting the interior, we await direction from the materials manufacturer regarding our next steps.
- We have received bids to have the three frescos behind the altar cleaned. This will require another round of scaffolding! After consulting the Finance Council, I have been advised to proceed with this project soon. An exact time line is not known, but the project will only affect the sanctuary for about three weeks.
