IMMACULATE CONCEPTION

This year, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception falls (December 8) falls on a Sunday. This feast of our Lady is particularly dear to us in the USA since under this title we honor our Lady as the patroness of our nation. For that reason, Catholics are obliged to attend the celebration of the Mass for the feast no matter when the feast falls.

There is a complication this year since December 8 is a Sunday. The English Mass calendar transfers the feast to Monday, December 9 to favor the Second Sunday of Advent. Our US bishops have clarified that our obligation to attend Mass transfers with the feast day. Thus, Monday, December 9 is a Holy Day of Obligation.

Also note, the older Latin Mass calendar **does not transfer** the feast to December 9, but retains the feast on Sunday, December 8. As a result, attending Mass for the Feast of the Immaculate Conception on Sunday, December 8 at 9:15 a.m. will satisfy the obligation imposed by our US bishops. In other words, attendance at Mass on Monday, December 9 is not obligatory if you attend the 9:15 a.m. feast day Mass on Sunday, December 8. This conclusion was reached after consultation with canonists.
