
RESTORATION UPDATE

News about our renovation efforts:

- One more week remains until the painting in church is completed.
- The organ will remain covered for the duration of the paint work. We have a plan for the organ to be uncovered by November 7th.
- Our roofer is finalizing plans and gathering materials. He plans to be on site and removing our old roof by October 22nd.
- We have collected bids to clean the dust from our three large frescos. I didn't expect to take on this project so quickly after our ceiling restoration, but our financial position, and the advice of our Finance Council makes it pos-
- While the interior work is wrapping up, we still have a lot of projects underway. Please continue to pray for God's blessings on our efforts!
