PRAYER FOR POOR SOULS

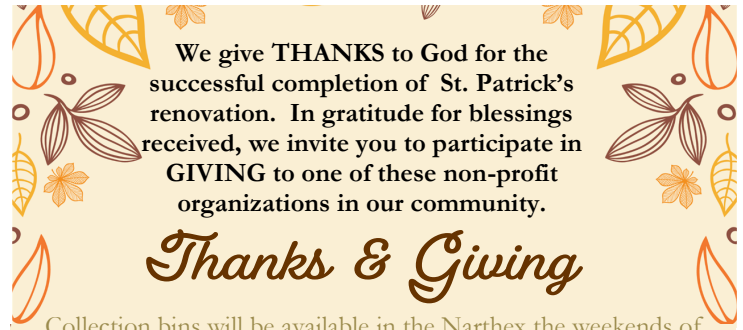

ADULT CONFIRMATION COURSE

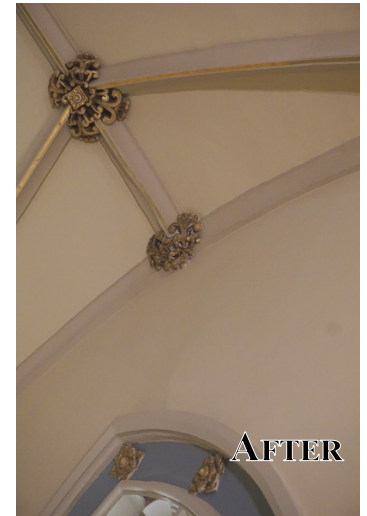
Class is **Sunday, November 17, 2024** from 12:15-1:30 p.m.

This past week in our renovation efforts:

- After more than five months of work, the interior repainting of the church walls and ceiling is complete! It is a testament to the hard work and professionalism of our contractors that our projects were on time and very close to being on budget. Most of all, it is a sign of God's goodness and the generosity of His people!
- The organ will be uncovered on November 7th and 8th.
- Our statue cleaning is making great progress. Restoration work on several statues will continue in the weeks ahead.
- Our roofer has begun the work to replace our church roof. As of now, plywood decking material has been delivered and the old metal panels are being removed.
- More projects are on the horizon, but they won't be as noticeable to our Sunday Mass-goers. We have received bids for a new rectory roof, upgrades to our church lighting system, and interior painting work in the parish office/rectory.
