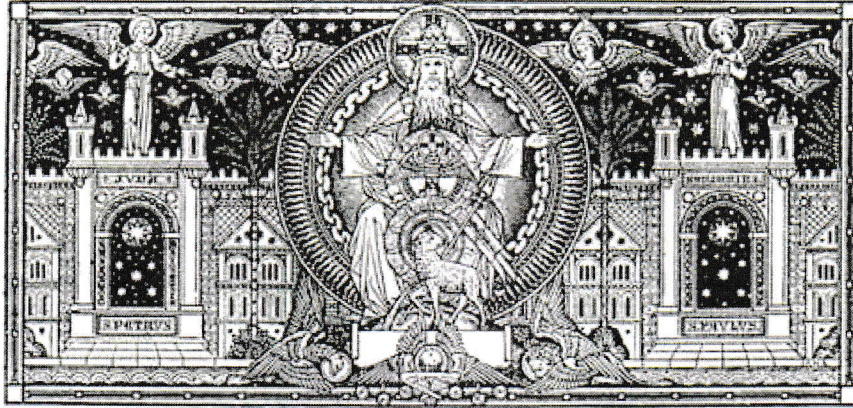

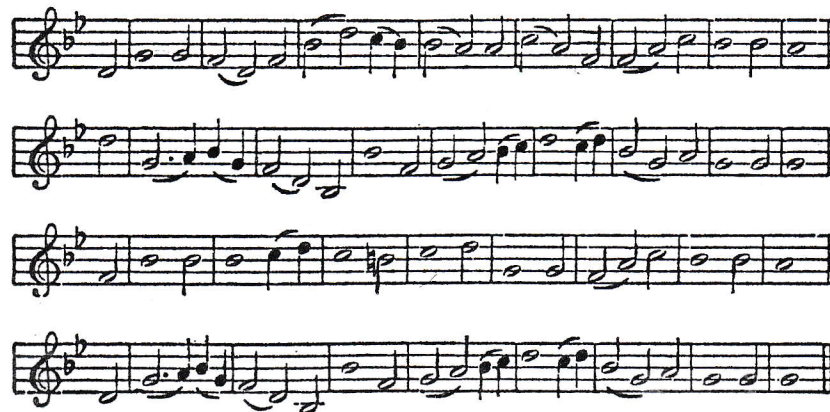
The Feast of the Most Holy Trinity

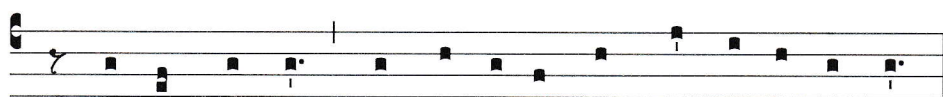

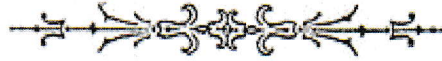
