SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

During the prayers and ceremonies of the Roman Canon, Abbe Barthe reflects that we become real witnesses, sacramentally, to the Lord's self-sacrifice. As we draw near to the time for Holy Communion, the signs and symbols then become oriented around the Lord's resurrection. In *A Forest of Symbols*, he relates that the Eucharistic elements of the Lord's Body and Blood are separated during the Canon, signifying His death. This is shown in the separate consecrations for the bread and wine. Then, following the *Pater Noster*, the Sacred Host is fractured and mixed into the Precious Blood. This ritual act shows His resurrection and is called comingling.

The chant proper to this act is the *Agnus Dei*. It is the recollection that Christ's self-sacrifice brings to fulfillment the sacrifices of old whereby the lamb was slain yearly in observance of Passover. Christ, does not remain slain, of course—but once His body is fractured on the cross, His life returns in resurrection; His body and blood rejoin in a biological sense as He conquers the grave. Similarly, as we proclaim His role as the new Lamb, that is, the Lamb once slain, we combine a particle of the Sacred Host into the chalice so we may witness for ourselves, in sacramental reality, His resurrection.

The rubrics direct the priest to accompany this great sign of the resurrection with the gesture of three crosses with the particle of the Host over the mouth of the chalice saying, *Pax Domini sit semper vobiscum*. Could we ever forget the Lord's first words to his Apostles after the resurrection, "Peace be with you?" As the particle of the Host is released into the Precious Blood, the priest prays, "May this mingling and hallowing of the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ avail us that receive it unto everlasting life." These words unite the sacramental signs of the resurrection to our own audacious aspirations that we may receive resurrected life as well.

The ritual elements of the fraction rite before Holy Communion are brief, but profoundly rich. Not only does the breaking of the Host symbolize our Lord's agonizing passion, but it also recalls the breaking of the bread which occurred for the disciples on the road to Emmaus (Luke 24). The three signs of the cross with the particle of the Host over the chalice also remind us of the three days that our Lord spent in the tomb before His Body and Blood were re-joined back to life in the Resurrection. These three signs also recall for us that three women were privileged to arrive at the empty tomb early in the morning only to be told, "Why do you seek the living among the dead?" (Lk 24:5). All of these signs are united in the same end: to display for us the Lord's resurrection. ~Fr. O'Brien
