SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Allow me to take a moment to update you about the event taking place this summer. Since last July, St. Theresa of Avila church has been on the market for sale. We are in dialog with a party that has made an offer, but a few months will pass before a commitment may be made. In that time, we will continue to ensure that every sacred article is safeguarded. We have also reached an agreement with the New Orleans Mission in regard to the St. John the Baptist rectory building. In September, they will begin renting the space while we prepare to sell the building to them. This arrangement will help our parishioners at St. John the Baptist Church to retain full use of the church building while we continue to resolve the ongoing operating deficit.

Back in the summer of 2024, as you recall, the St. Patrick's was a hive of activity with contractors, scaffolding and dust galore. Oh, the DUST! With that great undertaking behind us, we have decided to commemorate the renovation with a marble plaque which was just installed near the St. Anthony statue.



The summer of 2025 has brought another round of renovations and upgrades. These have been made possible by the generous support of parishioners through our maintenance collections, plus the memorial gift from the Thiele family. Let us pray for our benefactors! Mr. Michael Thiele, II is now remembered by means of a marble plaque near the Pietà statue.

The projects on the docket this summer have included a new roof on the parish rectory, repainting of the second floor of Reynold's hall (our music rehearsal room), organ repairs, repainting about half of the first floor of the parish rectory, thorough waterproofing of the church windows, and artistic touch-up to the faux-marble and fauxbois of the high altar and other fixtures around the church.

In addition to these, a steady stream of volunteers and college-age-parishioner-employees have been hard at work this summer. They have been able to repaint the front iron fence, repaint the restroom in Reynold's, catalog all the books in our parish library (which will be made public soon), and take on much needed cleaning and reorganization projects. Lastly, we are in discussions with an engineer and contractors so that, in the months ahead, we will repair and upgrade our church lighting system.

In all these efforts, it is the glory of God that we seek to make visible here on earth! May they assist us in the renovation of each soul into the image of Christ, Himself!
