


SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE


Building on last week's column, allow me to offer a few more children's book suggestions again this week. We must stay vigilant to ensure that our children's lives are steeped in the sacred. This is the best way to give them a foundation in prayerfulness and to equip them to face the opposition of the world, so eager, as it is to replace the sacred with the profane.



Brother William's Year offers young children a glimpse of monastic life of 14th century England, when Westminster Abbey was still a Catholic institution. The book takes the reader on a tour of the abbey with brief captions and large photos featuring explanations of what each month brings to the life of a monk.

Brides of Christ is written by the Benedictine sisters of Mary, Queen of Apostles in Missouri. It features a more in-depth look at the graces of monastic life, from ordinary activities to special monastic events. Children will enjoy the illustrations and the rhyming verse in which the book is written.





Of Bells and Cells was written as a labor of love, a collaboration between religious and laity. Its story is a little more complex for older audiences, but still is rich in illustrations. In addition to the themes of a life of prayer and discernment of vocations, this book also gives a brief overview of the different kinds of religious communities.

<u>Vocations</u> by Fr. William Doyle, SJ published by Os Iusti Press was originally published in the early 1900's It features no illustrations, but rather is an approachable guide for adolescent readers to deepen their attentiveness to God's call.
