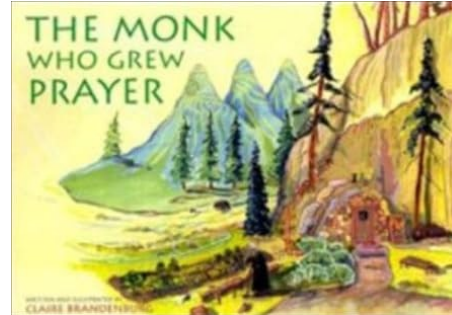

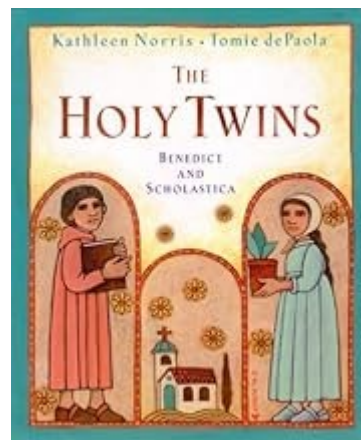
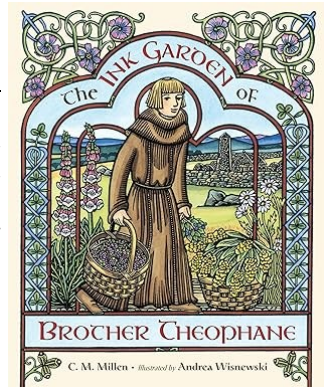
SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Building a Catholic culture starts with our young! It is very effective to use stories and books to immerse our children in the faith. Doing so helps them to see that topics of spirituality, vocation and faith belong in daily life. One of our faithful parishioners shared with me some books that she found which can help to make the faith a daily part of a child's life and help to plant the seeds of a vocation to the life of prayer.



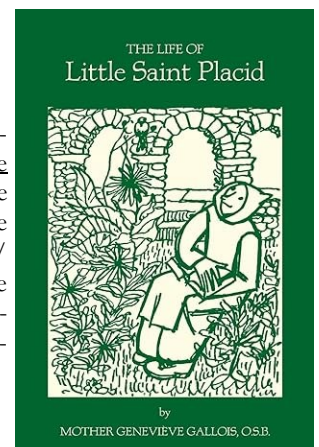
The Monk Who Grew Prayer by Claire Brandenburg explains to children the life of prayer embraced by the contemplatives. It includes page-sized illustration that will entice the minds of toddlers joined to a simple story about a faithful monk.

The Ink Garden of Brother Theophane by C.M. Millen takes these same themes and formats them for a slightly older audience. It gives a glimpse of medieval monasticism with large illustrations and a longer text.



An introduction to monastic life is incomplete without a close look at St. Benedict and St. Scholastica. The Holy Twins is a picture book with well-rounded story about the brother and sister who established western monasticism. While it contains large pictures to keep the interest of the young, it also conveys the spiritual mission and miraculous graces of these great saints.

Continuing on the theme of monasticism, she recommended The Little Life of St. Placid by Mother Genevieve Gallois, OSB. This story is much more complex and suitable for teens/adolescents. It give the reader a glimpse of life in a monastery, both the ceremonial aspects of it as well as the wholesome human dimension as well.
