Tuesday of the Fourth Week of Lent is commemorated:

Collect

Sacræ nobis, quæsumus, Domine, observationis jejunia: et piæ conversationis augmentum, et tuæ propitiationis continuum præstent auxilium. Per Dominum.

We beseech Thee, O Lord, that we may in such wise observe this solemn ordinance of fasting: that by reason of the same we may increase in all godliness of conversation, and effectually obtain the continual succour of Thy mercy. Through our Lord.

Secret

Hæc hostia, Domine, quæsumus, emundet nostra delicta: et, ad sacrificium celebrandum, subditorum tibi corpora mentesque sanctificet. Per Dominum.

Postcommunion
