SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

At the end of Masses, you have heard us chant the Regina Coeli. It is the proper antiphon for Eastertide sung at the conclusion of the hour of compline in the breviary. In the devotional life of the church, this chant also takes the place of the Angelus during the Easter season. There are two versions of the chant, one simple and one solemn. You might notice that the Solemn version is the same melody as the simple one, but made more melismatic and florid.

The text addresses Mary as Queen of Heaven, inviting her to rejoice in her Son's resurrection. In addressing her as Queen of Heaven, we lift up our praises not only for Christ's resurrection, but that she is, even now, enjoying a share in His glory.

Notice the rhyme scheme of the text: the first and second lines rhyme. The third line contains rhyming phrases, but 4th line is without. Tradition tells us the first three lines were heard by St. Gregory the Great sung by the angels on Easter day during a pestilence in Rome. The fourth line was added by St. Gregory himself. As such, the three angelic lines are elevated in style due their heavenly perspective, while the fourth line is laden with earthly concerns—the cry of a pastor shepherding a suffering people—and thus lacks the adornment of rhyme. Musically, we notice the “major” modality of the piece. This communicates Easter joy well by the uplifting, optimistic tonality it carries to our ears. ~Fr. O'Brien
