## SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE



I hope you have had the opportunity to take a close look at our paschal candle this year. Our Easter season is blessed by a hand-painted work of art that depicts Christ the King and High Priest.

Above the image of Christ, a banner reads, "Christus vincit, Christus regnat, Christus imperat." Meaning, "Christ conquers, Christ reigns, Christ commands."

The words come from a well-known ancient chant. They were sung at the coronation of King Charlemagne, and then for the Holy Roman Emperors. The words are also inscribed in the obelisk found at the center of St. Peter's Square in Rome.
