SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

On this Sunday when we lift our eyes and hearts to Christ ascending to the Father, I wish I could write this column on one of the countless joyful topics of the spiritual life. Sadly, though, a much more worldly concern has me preoccupied. On three different Sundays, an offensive image has been etched into the back of our church pews, most recently occurring last Sunday. The symbol (which I won't mention explicitly) implies grave antisemitic sentiment.

The symbol also cuts us to the heart, as Catholics as well. Not only did millions of Jews lose their lives due to this hatred, but thousands of Catholic priests were the target of unjust imprisonment and capital punishment by those same offenders. I bring this up to highlight the gravity of this three-time repeated vandalism we have suffered. In the state of Louisiana, even simple vandalism, if it is anti-religious in motivation is considered a hate crime and is punishable by 6 months incarceration.

God, who desires mercy and not sacrifice, is worthy of a holy sanctuary in which He may be worshiped, and the people of God give sacrificially to foster this beauty and sanctity. If you witness an act of vandalism occurring in church, please promptly report it to our security guard. By the intercession of St. Maximilian Klobe, martyr of the holocaust, let us pray for the grace to forgive and for the conversion of all hearts to Christ! ~Fr. O'Brien
