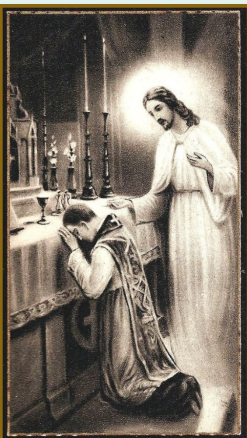

ARCHBISHOP'S VISIT—JULY 12

When Archbishop Checchio assumed his office here in New Orleans, he expressed a desire to visit all the parishes. We are joyfully anticipating his visit to St. Patrick's on July 12th.

His Excellency will attend the 9:15 a.m. Mass *in choro* and preach for us. His schedule that same day includes a Mass at another church at 11 a.m. so he will not be able to greet everyone at the end of Mass. Surely, we can look forward to this on another occasion!

SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

With so many wonderful parish celebrations behind us, we continue to give thanks to God for a most joyous springtime! Now as we return to the routine of *Tempus per annum*, I would like to resume the reflections on the diaconate in the life of the Church as compiled by our own Deacon Kenny Uhlich. Thus far, we have seen developments occur whereby deacons serve in a variety of roles. But one role that has been consistent from the start is the deacon's intimate connection with the liturgy and his nearness to the sacred elements of Christ's Body and Blood.

A glance at the ordination rite of the Eastern Church shows this connection as the deacons receive their sacred power after the Eucharistic prayer. This shows the deacon's special privilege of distributing the consecrated elements. In the west, the ancient liturgies confer sacred orders upon the candidate prior to the Gospel reading to highlight his new liturgical role of proclaiming the Gospel.

Tracing the origin of the diaconate to the Acts of the Apostles chapter 6, we all recall that the Apostles chose seven men to "serve at table" so that they could give greater focus to the spread of the Gospel. One might be initially tempted to see this original commission of the seven to be a purely pragmatic decision. But, the distribution of food, though a great work of charity, was not the only responsibility of these original seven. Joining the witness of Acts to the writings of St. Paul, we can further see the role of the deacon was more than charitable works, but they were counted among the hierarchy as well. Phil 1:1 addresses deacons among the church's leadership. 1 Tm. 3:8-13 outlines the moral and doctrinal qualifications for the important duties of deacons.

St. John Chrysostom points out the "table" at which the deacons served was that of both charity and liturgy. He writes, "The apostles laid hands on them...to minister at the table of the mysteries," and "they were to minister in spiritual things." Keep in mind that for Greek speakers, the word for mystery and the word for sacrament are one and the same.

St. Jerome echoes this understanding when he calls deacons "ministers of the mysteries of Christ." St. Cyprian of Carthage and St. Hippolytus lend their voices to this reality in the early church: a deacon's work was two fold, both to minister to those in need, while drawing close to God's sacred mysteries, the sacrament.

The tradition of the Church makes clear two distinct branches of ministry for deacons, charity and liturgy. We must also highlight the deep connection of these two as well! From the well spring of the sacraments, the deacon fills up the lives of the faithful in all their needs. ~Fr. O'Brien
